MEMORANDUM FOR FLWG CHECK PILOTS, GLIDER CHECK PILOTS, AND MISSION CHECK PILOTS

SUBJECT: 2017 Florida Wing Check Pilot School

1. The Florida Wing will be conducting the 2017 National Check Pilot Standardization Course on 11-12, February 2017 IAW CAPR 60-1. The course will be held at the Lakeland Airport Terminal building at the Lakeland Linder Airport.
2. Current check pilots and mission check pilots are required to attend the course in order to meet the annual requirements of CAPR 60-1 Paragraph 3-8e.
  - a. All renewing check pilot and mission check pilots must be current and qualified with a CAPF 5 and/or a CAPF 91 and be current in the CAP aircraft to be flown.
  - b. All renewing check pilots and mission check pilots must have completed the online NCPSC course for glider or powered, as required, within the past four years.
3. New check pilot and mission check pilot candidates must:
  - a. Be a CAP member for a least one year. Check pilot candidates must have held a CFI or CFI-G certificate for at least one year. Mission check pilot candidates must have participated in at least 25 mission sorties, either actual and/or training as a CAP SAR/DR mission pilot.
  - b. All applicants must be current with CAPR 60-1 requirements, be endorsed by a check pilot examiner on CAPF 5 Flight Evaluation or mission check pilot examiner on a CAPF 91 Mission Pilot Checkout, and be recommended by their Group Commander.
  - c. Applicants must complete the online NCPSC glider or powered course prior to attending the school.
  - d. For members with exceptional qualifications, a waiver to paragraph 3a may be requested through the chain of command to the FLWG DOV. These will be reviewed on a case by case basis.
  - e. Application for the course does not guarantee automatic acceptance.
4. In order to maintain certification, all current FLWG Check Pilots, Glider Check Pilots, and Mission Check Pilots are required to attend this annual course. Waivers will only be granted for significant life events. Requests for waivers must be routed from the member through the Group Commander to the Wing A3/DOV. The approving authority for waivers is the Wing CC.

5. Any member granted a waiver to the initial school will be required to attend a mandatory makeup class.
6. Members will register through the registration link on the FLWG website at [www.flwg.us](http://www.flwg.us) NLT 10 January 2017.
